Fall 2019

The graduate student enrollment of 1,230 includes 479 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2020 or Fall 2020. Demographically, seventy-five percent (930) of the graduate students are female, and 68.4% (841) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up nineteen percent of the group. Ninety-one percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Fifteen percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. Forty-seven percent are enrolled in 100% Online programs. The three largest graduate programs are the MA in Psychology, the MA in Clinical Mental Health Counseling, and the MS in Nursing.

Fall 2019

The graduate student enrollment of 1,109 included 407 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2019 or Fall 2019. Demographically, seventy-five percent (833) of the graduate students were female, and 65.1% (722) were from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation made up twenty-one percent of the group. Ninety-one percent of the students were U.S. citizens.

Twenty percent of the graduate students were classified as full-time. Thirty-six percent were enrolled in 100% Online programs. The three largest graduate programs were the MA in Psychology, the MS in Human Resources Management, and the MS in Nursing.
