Fall 2020

The undergraduate enrollment of 2,733 includes 668 new freshmen and 254 new transfer students for Fall 2020. Demographically, sixty-seven percent (1,822) of the undergraduates are female, and 73.9% (2,021) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up twenty percent of undergraduates.

For students with known addresses, 2,565 (93.9%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 92 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 79.7% of undergraduates.

Approximately 21% of undergraduates have declared a major in Nursing, while an additional 10% have declared Biology and nine percent Psychology.

Fall 2019

The undergraduate enrollment of 2,632 includes 727 new freshmen and 268 new transfer students for Fall 2019. Demographically, sixty-six percent (1,728) of the undergraduates were female, and 72.3% (1,902) were from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation made up twenty-two percent of undergraduates.

For students with known addresses, 2,477 (94.1%) had Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 85 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties made up 80.8% of undergraduates.

Approximately 20% of undergraduates had declared a major in Nursing, while an additional 10% declared Biology and eight percent Psychology.
