#### Fall 2021

The undergraduate enrollment of 2,780 includes 802 new freshmen and 241 new transfer students for Fall 2021. Demographically, sixty-five percent (1,818) of the undergraduates are female, and 75.9% (2,110) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up twenty percent of undergraduates.

For students with known addresses, 2,592 (93.2%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 85 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 78.6% of undergraduates.

Approximately 18% of undergraduates have declared a major in Nursing, while an additional 11% have declared Psychology and nine percent Biology.

#### Fall 2020

The undergraduate enrollment of 2,733 includes 668 new freshmen and 254 new transfer students for Fall 2020. Demographically, sixty-seven percent (1,822) of the undergraduates are female, and 73.9% (2,021) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up twenty percent of undergraduates.

For students with known addresses, 2,565 (93.9%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 92 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 79.7% of undergraduates.

Approximately 21% of undergraduates have declared a major in Nursing, while an additional 10% have declared Biology and nine percent Psychology.
