### Fall 2021

The transfer students of Fall 2021 included 241 students who entered the University in Summer 2021 or Fall 2021. Demographically, nearly sixty-one percent (148) of the new transfer students are female, and sixty-eight percent (164) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up seventeen percent (42) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 211 (87.6%) have Texas as their state of permanent address. Eighty-nine percent of the students are U.S. citizens. Sixty-eight percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 14% coming from an in-state four year institution and 54% from an in-state two year school.

Sixteen percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while eighteen percent declared Psychology.

### Fall 2020

The transfer students of Fall 2020 included 254 students who entered the University in Summer 2020 or Fall 2020. Demographically, nearly sixty-seven percent (170) of the new transfer students are female, and sixty-seven percent (170) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up eighteen percent (45) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 227 (89.4%) have Texas as their state of permanent address. Eighty-eight percent of the students are U.S. citizens. Sixty-seven percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 15% coming from an in-state four year institution and 52% from an in-state two year school.

Twenty-two percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while fifteen percent declared Psychology.
