Fall 2018

The transfer students of Fall 2018 included 263 students who entered the University in Summer 2018 or Fall 2018. Demographically, nearly sixty percent (153) of the new transfer students are female, and fifty-eight percent (152) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up nineteen percent (49) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 226 (85.9%) have Texas as their state of permanent address. Ninety percent of the students are U.S. citizens. Seventy-one percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 15% coming from an in-state four year institution and 56% from an in-state two year school.

Twenty-eight percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while ten percent declared Interdisciplinary Studies.

Fall 2017

The transfer students of Fall 2017 included 235 students who entered the University in Summer 2017 or Fall 2017. Demographically, seventy-two percent (169) of the new transfer students were female, and sixty-two percent (146) were from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation made up nineteen percent (44) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 214 (91.1%) have Texas as their state of permanent address. Ninety percent of the students were U.S. citizens. Seventy-five percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 15% coming from an in-state four year institution and 56% from an in-state two year school.

Thirty-five percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while 6.4% declared Psychology
